## PASTOR'S CORNER

### "Totus Tuus"

As we begin the spiritual pilgrimage of Advent to the celebration of our Lord's birth, we embark on this journey to Jesus through our Blessed Mother Mary, who said yes to God's call to become the Mother of His only begotten Son. Our late Holy Father, Saint John Paul II's papal motto "totus tuus" (totally yours) expresses the beautiful reality of us in faith belonging entirely to Jesus through Mary, whose Maternal love and care helps us to spiritually seek her Son and say to Jesus; "Live in me, Act in me Speak in me and through me." During this Advent season, we are prepared by the Holy Spirit to encounter Christ in faith more deeply at Christmas while becoming more aware of and ready for Him when He returns again at His second coming.

In embracing "totus tuus" as our parish motto for Advent, we express our complete and joyful acceptance of Mary's maternity in our lives as the Mother of Jesus and us who seek Him in faith. Her desire is for us to know Him more intimately and that our relationship with Jesus be strengthened in this most holy season of Advent.

To this end, beginning on December 3rd, we will begin as a parish family a Novena to Our Lady of Guadalupe, recognizing our Blessed Mother as the patroness of the Americas, and especially joining our brothers and sisters in Mexico as we together in faith spiritually seek to consecrate ourselves more fully to Jesus. We will be praying the Novena to our Lady of Guadalupe as a community at 5pm from December 3rd through December 12th at St. Rose. The novena will conclude with a special mass on the December 12th, which is the feast day of our Lady of Guadalupe. I encourage everyone to participate in the communal celebration of this Novena, the schedule for which will be listed in the parish bulletin. There will also be a copy of the Novena that will be available if you choose to pray it at home.

God bless you and your families as we begin our Advent journey to the joy of our Savior's birth.
