## SUNDAY REFLECTION

Friends, today we celebrate the feast of the dedication of the Lateran Basilica. But in doing so, we do not just celebrate the dedication of a building, but the mystery of what that building represents. The Lateran Basilica is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, the Pope, and thus the mother church of all churches in the world. But more than bricks and marble, this feast invites us to reflect on the deeper truth: that we are the living stones of God's temple. In our first reading, the prophet Ezekiel is shown a vision of water flowing from the temple, first a trickle, then a stream, then a mighty river. And wherever this water flows, life bursts forth. Trees bear fruit every month. The water teems with fish. Even the salty, lifeless sea is healed.

This is no ordinary river. It is the grace of God flowing from His dwelling place. And the astonishing part of this is that, in the New Covenant, that dwelling place is not just a temple in Jerusalem, it is us. That's why Saint Paul says, "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" (1 Cor 3:16). The river of life now flows from within us, if we allow Christ to dwell in us.

In the Gospel, Jesus enters the temple and finds it cluttered with commerce and noise. He drives out the money changers with righteous anger. "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace!" He cries out. But then He says something even more radical: "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." He was speaking of the temple of His body. Jesus is the new temple. And by baptism, we are joined to His Body. That means our bodies, our lives, our hearts—they are temples too. But like the temple in Jerusalem, they can become cluttered. Distracted. Polluted by noise, by selfishness, by sin.

So, Jesus comes to cleanse. Not with a whip of cords, but with mercy. With truth. With the fire of the Holy Spirit. He wants to drive out whatever keeps us from being fully alive in Him. Today we ask ourselves, how can we live as Temples of Christ? Let me offer three ways we can live this out: Guard the sacred space within. Just as the temple was a place of prayer, our hearts must be places of communion with God. What do we allow in? What voices do we listen to? What habits do we nurture? Let's make space for silence, for Scripture, for prayer. Secondly, let the river flow. Ezekiel's river didn't stay in the temple it flowed outward, bringing life. So must we. A temple is not a museum; it's a source of grace. When we forgive, when we serve, when we speak truth in love, we let the river flow. And lastly, bear fruit that lasts. The trees in Ezekiel's vision bore fruit every month. That's the kind of spiritual fruit God wants from us consistency, generosity, joy. Not just in the big moments, but in the daily ones: a kind word, a patient response, a quiet act of love.

There's a beautiful story of a child who, after visiting a grand cathedral, asked her parents, "Who are those people in the windows?" The mother replied, "Those are the saints." The child thought for a moment and said, "Oh, I see. Saints are people the light shines through." That's what it means to be a temple of Christ. To let His light shine through us. To be a place where others encounter the holy. To be not just a building of stone, but a living sanctuary of grace. So today, as we honor the Lateran Basilica, let's rededicate the temples of our own hearts. May the river of God's Spirit flow through us. May Christ dwell in us richly. And may we, together, become a Church that brings life to the world.
