## SUNDAY REFLECTION

Friends, last Sunday the First Sunday of Advent, we reflected on this season and said, it is a season of “sacred waiting”, but not a passive waiting. It is an active, expectant preparation for the coming of the Lord. Our readings for today continue with the same theme and remind us on how we are to prepare.

In the Gospel, we hear John the Baptist, a strong and central figure in our Advent liturgies crying out in the wilderness: “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand! Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.” His message is urgent, but it is also practical. And in the First reading, we see the Prophet Isaiah painting for us a beautiful picture of the gifts the Messiah will bring: wisdom, understanding, counsel, strength, knowledge, fear of the Lord, faithfulness, joy, justice, and peace. These are not material gifts wrapped in paper, but spiritual treasures that transform us from within. They are the gifts that make us whole, that bring peace to our lives, and that allow us to live in harmony with one another.

But here’s the challenge, the Lord cannot pour these gifts into us if our hearts are already cluttered. If we are filled with distractions, resentments, selfishness, or sin, there is no room for His Spirit to dwell. Preparing the way therefore means clearing out the bad stuff—like cleaning a house before welcoming a guest. We can also think of it this way, if you want to fill a cup with fresh water, you must first empty it of whatever is stale or dirty. In the same way, if we want to be filled with Christ’s wisdom, peace, and joy, we must first empty our hearts of pride, anger, greed, and distraction. This season therefore offers us a choice. We can get lost in the noise of the world, shopping, parties, writing cards, arranging foods, making travel plans and all the endless busyness or we can pause, look inward, and prepare a place for Christ. Today’s readings remind us that preparing for Christmas is not only about decorating our homes or checking off our shopping lists, but also opening our hearts to receive the gifts that only Christ can bring.

We can do so by trying to create quiet moments for prayer amidst the noise. Letting go of excess so we can focus on what matters. Seeking forgiveness, especially through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Opening our hearts to others, especially the poor and lonely. In trying all these things, we clear the path for Christ to enter. And when He comes, He does not come empty-handed. He comes with the gifts Isaiah promised, gifts that bring peace to our families, healing to our wounds, and hope to our world. What clutters your heart that John the Baptist is asking you to get rid of today?


