Pastor's Corner—My brothers and sisters in Christ, May the Lord continue to bless our families and our parish community! On this **All Souls Day**, we come together as a people of hope—remembering, honoring, and praying for all the faithful departed. We carry in our hearts the memory of parents, spouses, children, and friends who have gone before us. Their absence brings us sorrow, but our faith assures us that **death is not the end**.

Through the death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, **love is stronger than death**. We believe that the Lord prepares a place for each of His beloved children and that one day, we will be reunited with the joy of eternal life.

Today's liturgy reminds us of a profound truth: **We are a Communion—one Church—on earth, in purgatory, and in heaven**.

One of the most beautiful ways we live this communion is by **supporting the mission of the Church**, ensuring that the Gospel continues to be preached, the sacraments celebrated, and the poor served—so that more souls may be led to heaven.

Thank you to all who have already given so generously to the **Annual Catholic Appeal**. Your contributions support: Formation of new priests; Care of retired clergy; Religious education and youth ministry; Catholic schools; Charitable outreach to the most vulnerable, etc.

At **St. Joseph's Parish**, our goal is **\$17,941.00**. So far, **26 families** have generously pledged **\$5,208.00**. We still need **\$12,733.00** to reach our goal. If **50 families** could give **\$255.00** each, we would complete our parish's portion and help the Church continue her mission.

At **St. Anthony's Parish**, our goal is **\$33,111.00**. To date, **35 families** have pledged **\$16,570.00**, leaving us with **\$16,541.00** to go. If **30 families** could offer **\$552.00** each, we would meet our goal and strengthen our witness of faith and unity.

On this sacred day of remembrance, may we give not out of obligation, but out of love—for God, for His Church, and for all those we long to see again in the eternal embrace of heaven. Let us honor our beloved dead by helping build a Church that will guide future generations to Christ. Be assured of my prayers for you and for all the souls you hold dear. May eternal light shine upon them and may the Lord grant them eternal rest and peace.

May God bless our Parish! May the Lord continue to provide us with deeper faith and love in the Eucharist!

For the year from Oct 2024 through Sept 2025: Total deposits were \$31,312: of which \$11,463 were from St Anthony parish and St Anthony parishioners. Assistance provided was \$28,849: \$12,300 for City utilities, \$4827 for Avista, \$11,490 for rent, and \$232 for miscellaneous and administrative expenses. 




