The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude is based upon the German chorale *O Lamm Gottes, unschuldig* ("O innocent Lamb of God"), the text of which paraphrases the words spoken by John the Baptist in today's Gospel, as well as the words we sing every Sunday in the *Agnus Dei*. This setting is a tender expression of Jesus as the spotless Lamb of God, and is from the *Orgelbüchlein* (Little Organ Book) by Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750). The postlude is the toccata from *Variations on an American Hymn Tune* by American composer Gordon Young (1919-1998)—the hymn tune being "Nettleton" (known to us as "God We Praise You, God We Bless You"). 
