The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

The prelude comprises two introspective settings of the German hymn *Liebster Jesu, Wir sind hier* ("Dearest Jesus, we are here"). The third verse especially suits today's liturgical theme: "Glorious Lord, yourself impart; Light of Light, from God proceeding..." The composers are Max Reger (1873-1916) and Sigfrid Karg-Elert (1877-1933). The postlude—"Dialogue sur les Grands Jeux," from *Messe pour les Couvents* by François Couperin (1668-1733)—is a joyful exchange between different combinations (*jeux*) of the organ's stops, and can be seen as expressing this line from today's Old Testament reading: "Anguish has taken wing, dispelled is darkness: for there is no gloom where but now there was distress."
