

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude and postlude are based upon the German chorale *Wer nur den lieben Gott lässt walten* ("He who lets only our dearest God guide him"). The words to this hymn convey the spiritual ethos of the Beatitudes, as found in today's gospel reading. The two settings for the prelude were composed by Max Reger (1873- 1916). The postlude is from Johann Sebastian Bach's (1685-1750) *Orgelbüchlein* (Little Organ Book), a collection of chorale-based pieces for the liturgical year. 
