

**The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy**

Today's prelude, "You Satisfy the Hungry Heart," is based upon the familiar communion hymn by Robert Kreutz. The words to the refrain complement the words from today's Old Testament reading: "If you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted, then light shall rise for you in the darkness..." The composer is Charles Callahan (1951-2023). The boldness of the postlude – "Processional Fanfare" by Noel Rawsthorne (1929-2019) – reminds us of Jesus's injunction in today's Gospel: "...your light must shine before others..."
