The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

The prelude and postlude for today's liturgy are by British composer Desmond Ratcliffe (1917-2001). The winsome and innocent air of the prelude (titled simply "Prelude") recalls a verse from today's psalm: "Blessed are they whose way is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord...who seek him with all their heart." The decisiveness of the postlude (titled "Epilogue") harkens back to today's Entrance Antiphon: "Be my protector, O God, a mighty stronghold to save me. For you are my rock, my stronghold!..." 


