The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

*"To you I call; for you will surely heed me,
O God...in the shadow of your wings protect me."*

*"Behold, the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him,
who hope in His merciful love,
to rescue their souls from death..."*

These scriptures, from the Entrance Antiphon and Communion Antiphon respectively, inspired the selection of today's prelude: a pensive piece by French organist/composer Gaston Litaize (1909-1991) taken from his *Préludes Liturgiques*. Likewise, the postlude comes from the same set, but was chosen to express the idea of persistence that is found in today's Epistle and Gospel. The composer does this through the repeating patterns that permeate the musical texture. If you would like more information, please ask our organist, Joseph Schubert.
