A Concert of Organ Music



First Friday Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration with Benediction is the first Friday of the month immediately following the 8:15AM Mass. The students of Cataldo at St. Augustine join us to spend time praying before the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration is followed with Benediction

at 11:10AM.

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude is by the famous 19th century German composer, Johannes Brahms (1833-1897). Although he is renowned for piano, symphonic, and choral music, in his last year of life, perhaps pondering his own mortality, he composed his *Eleven Chorale Preludes* using an introspective, tender, and at times even heartbreaking musical language. I have chosen the second of his two settings of the chorale *O Welt, ich muss dich lassen* ("O world, I must leave thee") as a fitting prelude for today's somber liturgy. The postlude, *Elegy*, likewise speaks in a more muted language than last week's bombast. English organist Harold Darke (1888-1976) has given us in this piece a poignancy that reflects the highs and lows of a life remembered, and ends with a quiet prayer for the soul of a departed loved one.
