
What a Chili-licious Time We Had at Our Annual Potluck!

Today's prelude—Meditation, by French composer Gabriel DuPont (1878-1914)—is imbued with a beautiful flow and warm harmonies which reflect the lovely imagery of the Entrance Antiphon and Old Testament reading. In contrast, in the postlude—"Ascription," from Saint Francis Suite—20th-century composer Richard Purvis (1913-1994) seeks to portray a verse from the writings of St. Francis which parallels today's psalm: "O most high, almighty, good Lord God, to Thee belong praise, glory, honor, and all blessing." 


