The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

From today's Entrance and Communion Antiphons, we have the following scriptures:

"The Lord said, I think thoughts of peace and not of affliction..."

"To be near God is my happiness, to place my hope in God the Lord."

The prelude, "Andante cantabile," from Symphonie No. 4, by Charles-Marie Widor (1844-1937), is meant to express the calm, peaceful hope found in those scriptures. The postlude, a joyful canzona by Andrea Gabrieli (1510-1586), transcribed by Joseph Bonnet, is more in line with the Responsorial Psalm: "With trumpets and the sound of the horn sing joyfully before the King, the Lord."
