#### PAJAMA DRIVE!




The Faith in Action Ministry is hosting a pajama drive to benefit the Catholic Charities shelters in the Spokane area.

#### **Background on the Gospel Reading**

Today we hear about how Jesus, continuing on his journey to Jerusalem, heals 10 lepers. This story is a lesson about faith and reminds us that faith is sometimes found in unlikely places. Ten people afflicted with leprosy cry out to Jesus. Struck with pity, Jesus heals all 10. However, only one is described as glorifying God and returning to thank Jesus. The one who returns is a Samaritan, a foreigner. In the Jewish circles in which Jesus lived, Samaritans were looked down upon because of the differences between the two communities in their observance of Judaism. It is significant, therefore, that Jesus commends the Samaritan for his faith, which has been his salvation. Throughout Luke's Gospel, faith is found in surprising places.

Another lesson for us in this Gospel has to do with salvation. All 10 of the lepers were given the gift of healing, but in his gratitude to God for this gift, the Samaritan found salvation. Our salvation is found in recognizing the gifts we have been given and knowing to whom we must offer our thanks.

### **Spotlight on Young Saints**

#### St. Maria Goretti

October 16, 1890 – July 6, 1902: Died at Aged 11 **Canonized** June 24, 1950, by Pope Pius XII

Alessandro Serenelli was sentenced to 30 years of prison on October 11, 1902 for the murder of 11-year Maria Goretti. There are some who probably think he deserved the



death penalty. Maria Goretti was not one of them. He was unrepentant for her murder and quite nasty to all who tried to talk to him about it. That is until he learned something important. Bishop, Monsignor Giovanni Blandini, visited him in jail and gave him some starling information about his murder victim.

Maria like St. Stephen, like Christ, forgave her killer. She wanted him in heaven with her. This broke Alessandro. His heart was further broken and also strengthen by his murder victim appearing to him in a dream and handing him 14 white flowers, which corresponded to the number of stab wounds she received. These flowers burned up in his hand. She had come from heaven to personally offer him forgiveness. WOW. How could that not soften the hardest heart. —*Catholic Advocate*


