Lenten Food Drive

The Lenten Food Drive begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18th and will run through Sunday Mass on March 29th. Please bring your canned/dry food donations to the table in the Narthex. All donations are greatly appreciated; however, the items most needed include: fruit cups, granola bars, protein bars, soups, peanut butter, jelly, cereal, cooking oil, coffee and coffee filters, powdered coffee creamer, sugar, flour, spices; (salt, pepper, garlic powder, onion powder), condiments; (mustard, ketchup, mayonnaise) sauce mixes; (spaghetti, gravy, taco, etc.), jars of spaghetti sauce, dried pasta, applesauce, instant meals; (mac & cheese cups, ravioli, chili, instant noodles, rice), Saltine crackers, individual snacks for kids; (fruit snacks, fruit roll-ups, cheese and crackers, goldfish, granola bars) powdered milk, canned milk (shelf stable milk), pancakes in a cup, canned chicken and tuna. In addition to our food collection, we will be collecting diapers, wipes, formula, Pedialyte, Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Cough Drops, and Antacids.
