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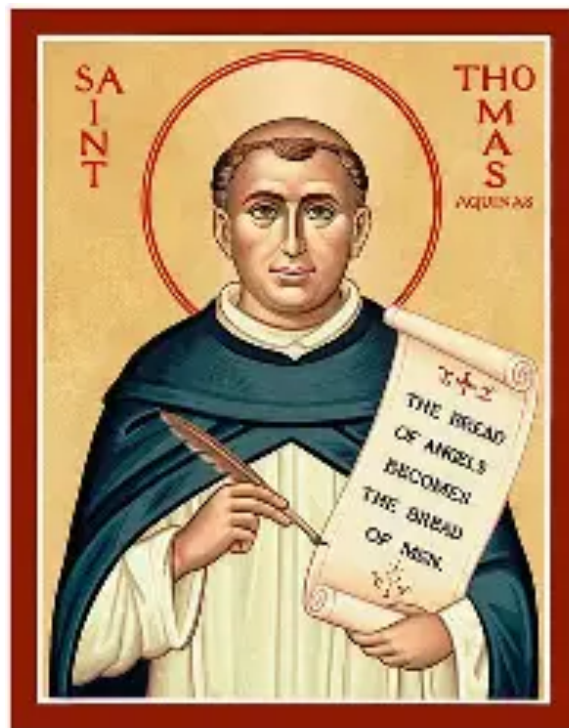

ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

Saint Thomas Aquinas, a Doctor of the Church, harmonized Aristotelian philosophy with Catholic doctrine. He accepted Aristotle's idea that the soul is infused at "formation" (40 days for boys, 80 for girls), but firmly taught abortion violates natural law and is always gravely wrong (CCC 2271). Modern science, unknown to Aquinas, shows human life begins at conception, aligning with Psalm 51:5, where David acknowledges sinfulness from conception, implying a soul from that moment. Aquinas experienced profound mystical visions late in life, which he said made his writings "like straw" compared to divine revelation, yet this was not a retraction of his theology (CCC 2032). Pope Leo XIII later endorsed Thomistic philosophy, affirming Aquinas's enduring authority in the Church.
