

THE MEANING OF ASH WEDNESDAY

- ASHES WERE USED AS A SIGN OF REPENTANCE IN THE OLD TESTAMENT
- ASHES ARE A PUBLIC SIGN OF OUR INTENT TO DIE TO OUR WORLDLY DESIRES AND LIVE IN CHRIST
- ASHES ALSO SYMBOLIZE GRIEF, IN THIS CASE, GRIEF FOR OUR SINS.
- AS OUR FOREHEADS ARE BEING MARKED, THE PRIEST SAYS: "REMEMBER THAT YOU ARE DUST AND UNTO DUST YOU SHALL RETURN"
- THE ASHES COME FROM THE BLESSED PALMS USED IN THE PALM SUNDAY CELEBRATION OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR

THREE PILLARS OF LENT

#LENTFAQ

In Christianity, Lent is a religious observance that commemorates the 40-days Jesus Christ spent fasting in the desert while simultaneously fighting off temptation and Satan.

PRAYER
Praying is the act of speaking to God either privately or in a religious ceremony in order to express gratitude, admiration, and love or to ask for something.

FASTING
Fasting is the act of abstaining from all or some kinds of food or drink, especially as a religious observance, for health reasons, or for ethical purposes.

ALMSGIVING
Almsgiving is the practice of donating money, food, or clothing to the poor. It is a sign of gratitude for all the things that God has blessed us with.

Lent is a religious observance that commemorates the 40-days Jesus Christ spent fasting in the desert being tempted by Satan. The religious period which starts exactly 46 days before Easter Sunday is observed by millions of people around the world.

DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

JESUS promised many graces!

JESUS promised many graces to those who venerate this Image and wanted it made known throughout the whole world.

Assurance of Salvation: Jesus told St. Faustina, "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish." This is a powerful assurance of Divine Protection direct from Jesus.

Blessing and Presence: Jesus said, "My gaze from this image is like My gaze from the cross." When we pray before the image, we are spiritually in His presence, Jesus looks at us with compassion and mercy.

Call to Mercy: Venerating the image also calls us to live mercifully. Jesus emphasized that even strong faith is ineffective without works of mercy.

Divine Rays: The red and pale rays symbolize Blood and Water—graces flowing from Jesus' Heart. Those who dwell in their shelter are promised protection from Divine Justice.

Enemies retreat: Jesus promised victory over spiritual enemies, especially at the hour of death. He said, "I Myself will defend it as My own glory."

Flow of Mercy: The inscription "Jesus, I trust in You" is not just any ordinary phrase—it's a spiritual posture of trusting in God. Trust unlocks the flow of mercy and helps us to remember to trust in God.

Graces: Jesus described the image as a "vessel of graces" through which souls can continually draw mercy, healing, and strength.
