

Lent: The gift of Divine Mercy

As we begin this Lenten season as a parish community, it is an opportunity for us to realize spiritually in our walk of faith the Lord's presence in our lives where we He is not our focus, and His desire to open our hearts to Him that we might begin to see ourselves and others as we are truly called to be in God through the Mercy of His Son. In this regard, Lent is a time of prayer and reflection as the Lord comes to us with His love and mercy that we have the strength in Him to be honest with ourselves about those areas of our lives that are broken, painful, uncomfortable and in need of His mercy. As we turn to the Lord in such places of struggle and pain we find peace and joy during this Lenten season as His Divine Mercy moves us to a greater desire to focus and center our lives on Him.

Immediately following our Saturday vigil and Sunday Masses in Lent, we will gather as a community to pray the Divine Mercy chaplet in the church. For those not wishing to participate in praying the divine mercy chaplet, I ask that you leave the church in silence like we do at the celebration of the Liturgy on Good Friday.

Please be assured of my prayers for everyone and I humbly ask for yours that this Lenten season will be spiritually fruitful for us all.
