The talk will include catechesis on relics and how to venerate them, a history of relics in the Church, and stories of miracles associated with relics of the Saints. What is the difference between a first and second class relic?

A first class relic is a part of the Saint's body, such as hair or bone. A second class relic is a part of something used by the Saint during their lifetime, such as clothing, a religious habit, or the item used during their martyrdom.
