

Pastor's Corner

Father David's Letter from 11/9
Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." The Jews said, "This temple has been under construction for forty-six years, and you will raise it up in three days?" But he was speaking about the temple of his Body. ~John 2:19-21

The most important temple is the temple of a person's soul because God dwells within each one of us. In the most secret center of our being is that sacred sanctuary where we meet God. Saint Teresa of Ávila called it the Presence Chamber, the most central and interior dwelling place within us.

Today is the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome which is the Cathedral of Rome and thus it is the Mother Church of the whole world. Like the temple of one's soul, this sacred place exists for people to encounter Christ deeply when going there to pray and worship God as a faithful follower of His Son. During my time in Rome as a seminarian I would often go to pray at the Lateran Basilica between classes at the St. John Paul II Institute which was right next door to our Mother Church. It was truly a special time to encounter the Lord in the temple of my soul while praying at this sacred place dedicated to both John the Baptist and John the Evangelist; two holy men of God who intimately knew Christ as our Savior.

As we honor the dedication of the Lateran Basilica today it is a reminder that all Catholic churches and parishes are sacred places that exist solely so people can encounter Jesus in the sanctuary of our soul, where the Lord is living and dwelling within us all. Please pray for the pope in a particular way today, that Saint John Lateran will always be a place where he, and every pope after him, will encounter God in a profound way.

Prayer: Christ our Savior, through the intercessions of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist, I pray for the Church today. I pray for your abundant mercy upon every sinner whom you are calling into your Church for reconciliation. I pray for my local parish, diocese, country, and the Universal Church headed in Rome. I especially pray for the Holy Father, the pastor of the Lateran Basilica and shepherd of the whole Church. Draw him close to You, make him holy, and use him to draw many people to Yourself. Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist, pray for us. Jesus I trust in You.

St. Frances Xavier Cabrini (Mother Cabrini)

Feast Day: Thursday, November 13



Quick facts: Mother Cabrini was born in Italy and received her Catholic education there. She became "Mother Cabrini" in 1877. She was later urged to go to the United States which was becoming flooded by Italian immigrants. Mother Cabrini founded 67 institutions for the poor, sick, and uneducated spread out through the US in New York, Colorado, and Illinois. She died of illness at 67 years old. Patron of: Immigrants and hospital administrators Simple Ways to Celebrate: If you live in Colorado, make a pilgrimage to Mother Cabrini shrine and pack a picnic. Bring meals to those experiencing homelessness in your community, bring a meal to someone who is ill. Make hearts for the homeless.
